

Wild Heart Necklace

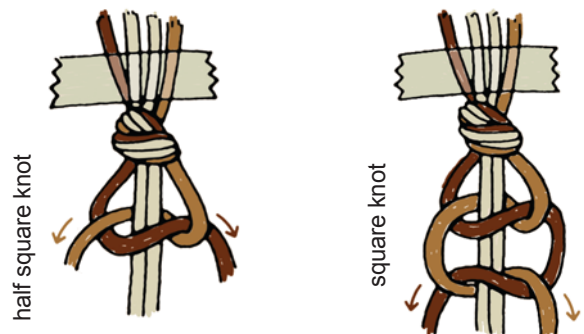
Round up 13 wild beads and a heart-shaped button. Cut 2 pieces of hemp cord each 10 feet long. Fold them in half and tie an overhand knot near the folded end, making a loop that'll go over the button. Tie 5 square knots and slide a bead on the inner cords...do this over and over till it's long enough. Slide the heart button on the inner cords and overhand knot the 4 ends together.



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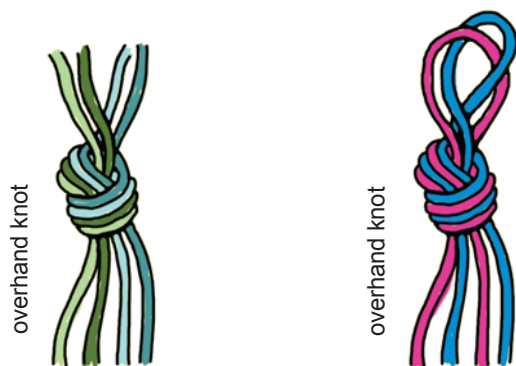
Square Knots

For square knots, tie an overhand knot and separate the cords into 4 sections. Tape down the knotted end and to keep the inner cords taut, pin the other end of the 2 inner cords to your shirt. Tie a square knot and pull it tight.



Overhand Knots

To knot one end, cut your strands and hold 'em together. Leave a 4" tail and tie an overhand knot near one end. For an end loop, double your strands and tie an overhand knot near the folded end.
