

## Cat's Butterfly

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### Finished Size:

Approximately 4½" wide (11.5 cm)

### MATERIALS

100% Cotton Medium Weight Yarn  
Main Color (Yellow or Variegated) -  
15 yards (13.5 meters) each  
Black - 4 yards (3.5 meters) each  
Knook size H (5 mm)  
8 mm Craft bell - 1 each  
Yarn needle



Gauge is not of great importance.

### TOP WING (Make 2)

With Main Color, ch 12.

Pick up 11 sts on foundation ch: 12 sts.

**Rows 1-10:** Knit across.

Cut yarn leaving a long end for sewing and thread yarn needle with end. Slip stitches from cord onto yarn needle and draw end through, then draw through the stitches a second time; draw up tightly, leave end for sewing Wing to Body.



## BOTTOM WING (Make 2)

With Main Color, ch 6.

Pick up 5 sts on foundation ch: 6 sts.

**Rows 1-6:** Knit across.

Cut yarn leaving a long end for sewing and thread yarn needle with end. Slip stitches from cord onto yarn needle and draw end through, then draw through the stitches a second time; draw up tightly, leave end for sewing Wing to Body.

## BODY

With Black, ch 6.

Pick up 5 sts on foundation ch: 6 sts.

**Row 1:** Purl across.

**Row 2:** Knit across.

**Rows 3-10:** Repeat Rows 1 and 2, 4 times.

Cut yarn leaving a long end for sewing and thread yarn needle with end. Slip stitches from the cord onto yarn needle and draw end through; then sew ends of rows together, do **not** cut end.

Stuff Body with Black yarn. Sew beginning edge together, then using same end, sew the bell to seam, wrapping yarn around the shank of the bell several times before securing end.

Using photo as a guide, sew Wings to Body.

colon (:) — the number(s) given after a colon at the end of a row denote(s) the number of stitches you should have on that row.

## GAUGE

Gauge is a measurement of the number of stitches and rows in a 4" (10 cm) square piece in the pattern you're working. Exact gauge is not important in this pattern as the Butterfly can be a little larger or smaller without changing the overall effect.
