

## Scarf



**Finished Size:** 7<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 46<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" (18.5 cm x 118 cm)

### MATERIALS



Medium Weight Yarn  
[5 ounces, 244 yards  
(141 grams, 233 meters) per skein]: One skein  
Knook size G (4 mm)

**GAUGE:** In pattern, 15 sts = 4" (10 cm); 24 rows = 3" (7.5 cm)

### SCARF

Ch 27.

Pick up 26 sts on foundation ch: 27 sts.

**Rows 1-8:** Knit across.

**Row 9:** K4, P 19, K4.

**Row 10 (Right side):** Knit across.

**Row 11:** K4, P 19, K4.

**Rows 12-20:** Knit across.

**Row 21:** K4, P 19, K4.

Repeat Rows 10-21 until Scarf measures approximately 45<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" (115.5 cm) from beginning ch, ending by working Row 11.

**Last 8 Rows:** Knit across.

Bind off all sts in **knit**.



# General Instructions

## ABBREVIATIONS

ch(s)	chain(s)
cm	centimeters
K	knit
mm	millimeters
P	purl
st(s)	stitch(es)

() or [] — contains explanatory remarks.

colon (:) — the number(s) given after a colon at the end of a row denote(s) the number of stitches you should have on that row.

right vs. wrong side — On the finished piece, the right side of your work is the side that the public will see.

## GAUGE

Gauge is a measurement of the number of stitches and rows in a 4" (10 cm) square piece in the pattern you're working. Finding the exact gauge is not important for this pattern as the Scarf can be a little larger or smaller without changing the overall effect.
